Это большой шумный город. Много людей живет в этом городе.

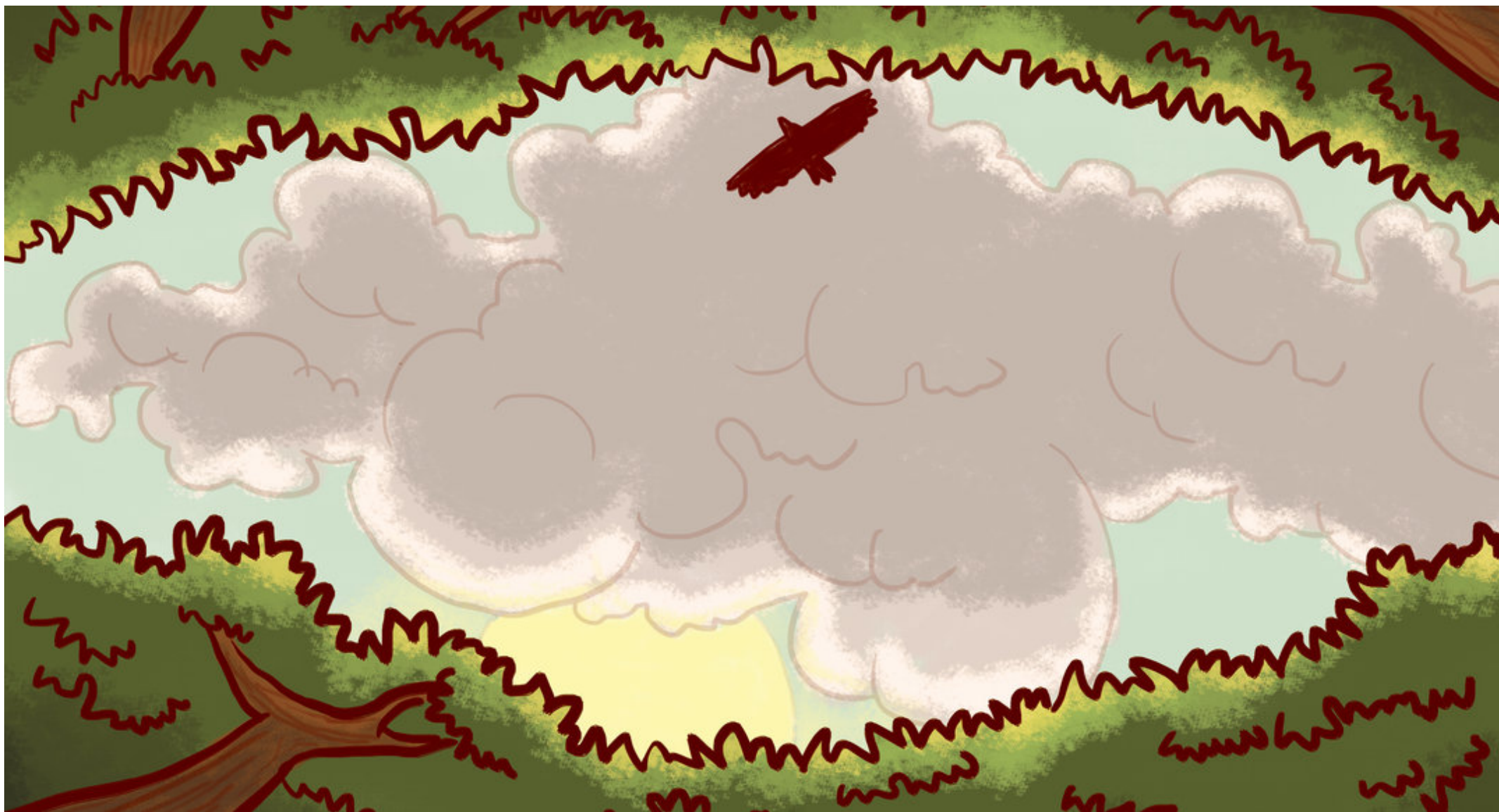
Но в таких многолюдных городах растёт лишь несколько деревьев.

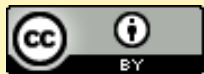

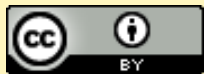
